## Enhancing ICID's Membership

- The Central Office, under the guidance of the President and with support from the Vice Presidents, is actively driving membership expansion by engaging both associate member countries and non-member nations.
- Regular letters have been sent to the Ministries of Water Resources and Agriculture, as well as diplomatic consulates and embassies in New Delhi, to encourage the reactivation of associate memberships; to attract new members and leveraging connections within the technocrat community.
- The ICID Central Office has reached out to the 31 Associate Members, requesting them to renew their membership and rejoin ICID as members.
- The ICID Central Office has contacted 40 new countries, asking their Ministries of Water Resources; Agriculture, or Embassies in India to consider joining ICID as members.





#### Road Map to ICID Vision 2030

- Road Map to ICID Vision 2030 launched at the Mexico City Meeting during 69<sup>th</sup> IEC Plenary.
- Evolved a MONITORING MECHANISM to review the ACTION PLAN of the Road Map 2030 Periodical review of the activities identified under various strategies by the respective WBs reporting to PCSO and PCTA. In addition, overall monitoring by the Co-Theme Leaders of Strategy Themes in case of PCTA WBs.
- IEC will review at its main session on 7 September 2024 under Agenda Item 9





## Knowledge Management

Knowledge is crucial for successful and sustainable development initiatives in the AWM domain. Knowledge management involves how it is collected, organized, communicated, shared, and improved and needs to be given due attention to achieve the mission and vision of the organization. It is equally important that all stakeholders have access to information and knowledge, both traditional and new, that is based on scientific evidence.



### Knowledge Management

- From last seven decades, ICID has accumulated a substantial amount of knowledge, particularly in the field of irrigation and drainage.
- Commission uses the following platforms to disseminate:
  - Publications & Reports ICID brought out 11 special publication since 2019; 10 transactions since 2008; and 10 reports since 2010
  - Capacity Development two Capacity Development Training Programs, and six Webinars were organized during the year 2023-24
  - Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)\*
  - Irrigation Dictionary (MTD)\*
  - Irrigation & Drainage Products & Services Directory
  - Join IrriSEARCH
  - Tools/ Models
  - ICID Service Unit (SU) Study Tours, Trainings, etc.
















### ICID Knowledge Portal

  - Further development could not be taken up due to budgetary limitation


ICID Knowledge Objects (K-OBJ)
