

Working Group on Water – Energy – Food Nexus (PH Prof. Ragab Ragab)

- Webinar organized on 'Application of Models in the WEF-Nexus' held on line in April 2024 with the attendance of more than 170 participants.
- Significant contribution to the World Water Forum 10: Water for Shared Prosperity 19-25 May 2024, Bali, Indonesia.
- An International Workshop on 'The Water-Food-Energy Nexus: Applications & Impact on Societies, Environment and Ecosystem' took place on the 01 September 2024 in Sydney, Australia and producing the proceedings.
- Several presentations were shared with participants during the International Workshop on WEF Nexus.

Working Group on Rain Water Harvesting (VPH Prof. Ding Kunlun on behalf of Mr. Geoff Harvey)

- Restructuring the WG on RWH ((WG- Irrigated Agriculture under Drought and Water Scarcity (MWSCD) has been integrated with WG-RWH))
- Compiling a scoping document for the new WG.
- New Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary of the new WG were elected.
- Preparing the new action plan of the WG.
- Investigating advantages and disadvantages of Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) and its possible use for irrigation and domestic and urban areas



Working Group on Sustainable Regenration of Coastal Environment (SECR) Dr. Ruey – Chy Kao

- Restructuring the new WG- SCER under strategy theme 2 "Natural Resources and compiling a Scoping Document for the new WG. (WGs on AFM, IDM, and M&R are integrated with WG- SDTA forming WG-SCER).
- □ New Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary of the new WG were elected.
- Compiling the action plan of the new WG of the road map to ICID vision 2030.
- Following up pending issues of the merged WGs particularly the publications of the WGs.





Working Group on Irrigation and Drainage in the States under

Socio Economic Transformation (IDSST))

Chaired by Prof. Peter Kovalenko

- Compiling the roadmap to ICID vision 2030 based on the new mandate of the WG.
- Strengthening the network among the transition states on the bases of establishment of monitoring and evaluation of common problems in the states.
- □ Creating a database of Irrigation and Drainage in the states in transition.
- Monitoring and evaluating the ecological parameter in transition countries



Contract renewal proposal for Irrigation and Drainage

- The year 2024 is the sixth year of the 5th Agreement for the period 2019-2025.
 To ensure a seamless transition, as a first step, it was agreed that Wiley would be invited to submit a contract renewal proposal for *Irrigation and Drainage*.
- This proposal has been discussed with the chairman and other relevant persons. It was agreed that Wiley would submit the draft Agreement to Secretary-General for final check, approval and signing. The draft Agreement was sent on 1 July 2024.
- ICID CO has reviewed and approved it in principle the contract renewal proposal for *Irrigation and Drainage*.





Highlights of Publishing Partnership

- Since ICID partnered with Wiley, *IRD* has seen a significant rise in key metrics of success:
- Increase in global reach as the number of institutions with access to the Journal grew from 40 in 2001 to over 11,400 in 2023, including over 4,300 institutions in the developing world.
- Increase in readership with article downloads growing from circa 7,000 in 2001 to over 96,000 in 2023.
- Increase in output from 28 articles in 4 issues in 2001 to 123 articles in 5 issues in 2023.
- Increase in Impact Factor from 0.357 in 2002 to 1.9 in 2022.
