COURSE OVERVIEW

The Irrigation Meter Installation and Validation Skill Set (AHCSS00197) is nationally accredited and offers candidates the skills and knowledge to become an irrigation meter installer and validator. This course provides a hands-on learning experience and in-field assessment on candidates skills and knowledge in accordance with the Australian standard AS4747, when installing and validating non-urban water meters in rural environments.

After successful completion of the three day/four day course and satisfying all the competency requirements, participants will become a Certified Meter Installer and Validator – CMI/DQP and gain a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment.
