

METER INSTALLATION & VALIDATION

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Meter Installation and Validation course is nationally accredited and offers candidates the skills and knowledge to become an irrigation meter installer and validator. This training course provides a hands-on learning experience and in-field assessment on candidates skills and knowledge in accordance with the Australian standard AS4747, when installing and validating non-urban water meters in rural environments.

After successful completion of the three day/four day Meter Installation and Validation course and satisfying all the competency requirements, participants will become a Certified Meter Installer and Validator – CMI/DQP and gain a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment.

*We have reduced the price of the virtual course to accommodate students' need to complete third-party reports after the course. This will involve partnering with a current Certified Meter Installer to demonstrate competence in the practical components of the course. The responsibility will be on the student to organise these practical sessions. Irrigation Australia can partially assist by providing a list of current Certified Meter Installers or by offering options to attend the practical sessions of our face-to-face deliveries.
