

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Irrigation Pumps and Systems short course is designed to provide candidates the knowledge and skills required to operate and maintain irrigation pumping systems and install, test and maintain pumping systems to a national standard.

The course requires candidates to analyse information and exercise judgement to complete a range of activities that will demonstrate their skill and knowledge with irrigation pumping systems.

Start with a four-hour online session facilitated by an experienced trainer, then complete self-paced theory modules covering key topics such as pump selection and performance, pipeline system design, installation techniques, and troubleshooting pumping systems. A few weeks later, you'll attend a full-day practical workshop, where you'll put your skills into action, testing and assembling pumps, identifying faults, and fine-tuning system performance.
